Definitions

2006: Definition of sexuality (WHO)


- Sexuality is a central aspect of being human throughout life.
- It encompasses sex, gender identities and roles, sexual orientation, eroticism, pleasure, intimacy and reproduction.
- Sexuality is experienced and expressed in thoughts, fantasies, desires, beliefs, attitudes, values, behaviours, practices, roles and relationships.
- Sexuality is influenced by the interaction of biological, psychological, social, economic, political, cultural, legal, historical, religious and spiritual factors.

2006: Definition of sexual health (WHO)

- Sexual health is a state of physical, mental and social well-being in relation to sexuality. It is not merely the absence of disease, dysfunction or infirmity.
- Sexual health requires a **positive and respectful approach** to **sexuality** and sexual relationships, as well as the possibility of having **pleasurable and safe** sexual experiences, free of coercion, discrimination and violence.
- For sexual health to be attained and maintained, the sexual rights of all persons must be respected, protected and fulfilled.

2008: IPPF's declaration on sexual rights

- Sexual rights are human rights, related to sexuality
 - Constituted by a set of entitlements related to sexuality
 - They emanate from the rights to freedom, equality, privacy, autonomy, integrity and dignity of all people
- Contains three parts
 - Preamble
 - 7 guiding principles
 - 10 sexual rights
- Advocacy tool



2008: IPPF's declaration on sexual rights

- Sexual rights relating to infertility issues
 - «Right to health and to the benefits of scientific progress» (Article 7)
 - Right to the enjoyment of the highest attainable standard of physical and mental health.
 - Have the right and means to access or refuse reproductive health technologies, services or medical interventions (...) without discrimination.
 - «Right to choose whether or not to marry and to found and plan a family, and to decide whether or not, how and when, to have children» (Article 9)
 - The right to counselling and other services related to reproduction, infertility and pregnancy termination, (...)
 - The right to make free and responsible choices regarding reproduction and family formation (...), to decide whether or not to have biological or adopted children (...)

Its Mission and the Concept of Sexual Health

Definition of sexual health for Switzerland – FCSH 2015

- Sexual health: definition for Switzerland, based on 5 core areas of action (2015)
 - Sexual health as part of mental health
 - Reproductive health
 - HIV-STI-RTI (Reproductive Tract Infections)
 - Gender based violence
 - Comprehensive sexuality education

To be considered in a holistic and linked approach.



■ Sexual Health Centers specialised in reproductive health issues

 Offer services around pregnancy, post-partum care, abortion, contraception, fertility/infertility, pregnancy lost, sexuality, gender based violence, etc.

Services related to infertility issues are for exemple

- Counselling around the issues of fertility and infertility
- Psychological support to women and couples before starting an infertility treatment (according to the Federal Act on Medically Assisted Reproduction RMA)
- Information about Sexual Health and Rights
- Information about Fertility Awareness Methods
- Counselling around adoption
- Counselling for people LGBTI with a wish for a child
- Counselling about prenatal diagnosis (Swiss law on genetic testing of humans)
